



## EXODUS—departure!

### Exodus 1–4

- God's **promised, OUR PAIN, DESIRES** and God's **answers!**

<sup>13</sup> Then the LORD said to Abram, "You can be sure that your descendants will be strangers in a foreign land, where they will be oppressed as slaves for 400 years.

<sup>14</sup> But I will punish the nation that enslaves them, and in the end they will come away with great wealth. Genesis 15:13–14 (NLT)

<sup>29</sup> Then Moses and Aaron returned to Egypt and called all the elders of Israel together. <sup>30</sup> Aaron told them everything the LORD had told Moses, and Moses performed the miraculous signs as they watched. <sup>31</sup> Then the people of Israel were convinced that the LORD had sent Moses and Aaron. When they heard that the LORD was concerned about them and had seen their misery, they bowed down and worshiped. Exodus 4:29–31 (NLT)

### Exodus 4–11

- God's **MIRACLES** before experiencing **FREEDOM!**

<sup>21</sup> And the LORD told Moses, "When you arrive back in Egypt, go to Pharaoh and perform all the miracles I have empowered you to do. But I will harden his heart so he will refuse to let the people go. Exodus 4:21 (NLT)

**11** Then the LORD said to Moses, "I will strike Pharaoh and the land of Egypt with one more blow. After that, Pharaoh will let you leave this country. In fact, he will be so eager to get rid of you that he will force you all to leave. <sup>2</sup> Tell all the Israelite men and women to ask their Egyptian neighbors for articles of silver and gold." <sup>3</sup> (Now the LORD had caused the Egyptians to look favorably on the people of Israel. And Moses was considered a very great man in the land of Egypt, respected by Pharaoh's officials and the Egyptian people alike.)

### Exodus 12

- **PASSOVER!**—The beginning of **A NEW DAY** and an everlasting agreement!

<sup>14</sup> "This is a day to remember. Each year, from generation to generation, you must celebrate it as a special festival to the LORD. This is a law for all time.

...<sup>31</sup> Pharaoh sent for Moses and Aaron during the night. "Get out!" he ordered. "Leave my people—and take the rest of the Israelites with you! Go and worship the LORD as you have requested. <sup>32</sup> Take your flocks and herds, as you said, and be gone. Go, but bless me as you leave." <sup>33</sup> All the Egyptians urged the people of Israel to get out of the land as quickly as possible, for they thought, "We will all die!"

...<sup>40</sup> The people of Israel had lived in Egypt for 430 years. <sup>41</sup> In fact, it was on the last day of the 430th year that all the LORD's forces left the land. <sup>42</sup> On this night the LORD kept his promise to bring his people out of the land of Egypt. So this night belongs to him, and it must be commemorated every year by all the Israelites, from generation to generation. \*Reference all of Exodus 12:14–42 (NLT)

### Exodus 13–40

- Learning to live by **God's guidelines** and **instructions** on this journey!

...wrestling with **trust issues!**

...obedience and freedom—**a constant clash!**

...God's plan and protection for **right-living!**

...learning to live under **God's care!**

...**giving**, that will change your life and the life of others!

...<sup>4</sup> Then Moses said to the whole community of Israel, "This is what the LORD has commanded: <sup>5</sup> Take a sacred offering for the LORD. Let those with generous hearts present the following gifts to the LORD: gold, silver, and bronze;

...<sup>20</sup> So the whole community of Israel left Moses and returned to their tents. <sup>21</sup> All whose hearts were stirred and whose spirits were moved came and brought their sacred offerings to the LORD. They brought all the materials needed for the Tabernacle, for the performance of its rituals, and for the sacred garments. <sup>22</sup> Both men and women came, all whose hearts were willing. They brought to the LORD their offerings of gold—brooches, earrings, rings from their fingers, and necklaces. They presented gold objects of every kind as a special offering to the LORD...
