

“All Of US SINNERS, We Need SALVATION—JESUS!”



<sup>23</sup> For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. <sup>24</sup> Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. <sup>25</sup> For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, <sup>26</sup> for he was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and he makes sinners right in his sight when they believe in Jesus. <sup>27</sup> Can we boast, then, that we have done anything to be accepted by God? No, because our acquittal is not based on obeying the law. It is based on faith. <sup>28</sup> So we are made right with God through faith and not by obeying the law. Romans 3:23–28 (NLT)

### We All Are Without Excuse!

» Creation tells us there is a **supreme being and he is GOD!**

...<sup>20</sup> For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God... Romans 1:19–21 (NLT)

» We ALL were born with these two sensors:

our **CONSCIENCE and THOUGHT/MIND!**

<sup>14</sup> Even Gentiles, who do not have God's written law, show that they know his law when they instinctively obey it, even without having heard it. <sup>15</sup> They demonstrate that God's law is written in their hearts, for their own conscience and thoughts either accuse them or tell them they are doing right... Romans 2:14–16 (NLT)

» Being unwilling to **accept or acknowledge God's existence**

does not give us an exempted status!

<sup>9</sup> Well then, should we conclude that we Jews are better than others? No, not at all, for we have already shown that all people, whether Jews or Gentiles, are under the power of sin... Romans 3:9-20 (NLT)

» Jews and Gentiles... we are **ALIKE**, without excuse.

<sup>23</sup> For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. Romans 3:23 (NLT)

### God's Plan Of Salvation For ALL!!!

• **GOD made a way** when there seemed to be none ...it's called **FAITH!**

**5** Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. <sup>2</sup> Because of our faith, Christ has brought us into this place of undeserved privilege where we now stand, and we confidently and joyfully look forward to sharing God's glory. Romans 5:1–2 (NLT)

• Each new day, **CHOOSE to live a redemptive life** through the blood of Jesus Christ!

<sup>20</sup> When you were slaves to sin, you were free from the obligation to do right. <sup>21</sup> And what was the result? You are now ashamed of the things you used to do, things that end in eternal doom. <sup>22</sup> But now you are free from the power of sin and have become slaves of God. Now you do those things that lead to holiness and result in eternal life. <sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:20–23 (NLT)

• The **struggle** is not over **UNTIL** our life is over here on earth!

...<sup>18</sup> And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. I want to do what is right, but I can't. <sup>19</sup> I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. <sup>20</sup> But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it... <sup>24</sup> Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death?... Romans 7:14–25 (NLT)

• **COMMITT** to living **TODAY, TOMORROW** and the **NEXT DAY** with patience, hope and truth!

...<sup>38</sup> And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. <sup>39</sup> No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:28–39 (NLT)

• God's **original plan of SALVATION** for all people has not changed, **including ALL Jews!**

<sup>1</sup>...the longing of my heart and my prayer to God is for the people of Israel to be saved. <sup>2</sup> I know what enthusiasm they have for God, but it is misdirected zeal. <sup>3</sup> For they don't understand God's way of making people right with himself. Refusing to accept God's way, they cling to their own way of getting right with God by trying to keep the law. <sup>4</sup> For Christ has already accomplished the purpose for which the law was given. As a result, all who believe in him are made right with God. Romans 10:1–4 (NLT)
